








FILING PROJECTIONS



October total filings are **up 12.21**% compared to the same time period in 2024. This total is **19.46**% **below** the pre-Covid average* for the month of October.



October Chapter 7s are **up 11.34%** compared to the same time period in 2024. This total is **20.76% below** the Pre-Covid average* for the month of October.



October Chapter 13s are **up 13.22%** compared to the same time period in 2024. This total is **18.55% below** the Pre-Covid average* for the month of October.



October Chapter 11s are **up 27.68**% compared to the same time period in 2024. This total is **48.17**% **above** the Pre-Covid average* for the month of October.





